NursingCAS Instructions for TCU – Traditional BSN

Note: Applications to the Traditional BSN and the Accelerated BSN for transfer students are now being processed through NursingCAS. NursingCAS is the online, centralized application service for nursing schools. You can use NursingCAS to apply to Texas Christian University and other participating schools. NursingCAS processes your application and transcripts on behalf of the university.

Applicants interested in TCU's Traditional BSN or the Accelerated BSN for transfer students programs should apply through NursingCAS. Visit www.nursingcas.org and click "Apply Here" to initiate your application. And click on "Create Account" and complete the required fields in order to start your application. Additionally, please review the information below carefully and we recommend that you review this <u>information</u> before you begin your application as well. Although, some sections of the NursingCAS application are marked "optional" please follow the guidelines below for TCU requirements and note that your application will not be considered until ALL elements listed below as "Required for TCU" are completed and submitted.

Application Steps and Admission Requirements:

Complete the <u>NursingCAS Application</u> and all the application requirements outlined below. Note when creating your account, make sure you select "Yes" to the question "Are you applying to an undergraduate level program?" You may apply while you are finishing prerequisite courses; however, all coursework (both nursing prerequisites and TCU Core) MUST BE COMPLETED before the program begins. <u>Click here for a list of transferrable core curriculum requirements equivalency guide.</u>

Minimum GPA - Transfer students must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA from other colleges/universities to be considered for admission to TCU as a nursing major. Note Accelerated students must have a 3.0 GPA or greater in either undergraduate degree or nursing prerequisites (AP1, AP2, Micro, and Statistics)

Pursuing Nursing Major After Previous Nursing School Enrollment - Only transfer students in good standing and eligible for readmission to the previous program(s) will be permitted to pursue a nursing major at TCU.

Transfer Student Policies - The following are transfer policies for students wishing to declare nursing as their major.

Admission to TCU

- All applicants must be eligible for admission to TCU.
- All official academic transcripts must be mailed to NursingCAS.
- No grade less than C will transfer to TCU for academic credit. All courses in which applicants have been enrolled as well as earned grades are considered in the TCU admission process.
- Upon receipt of a formal application for admission to TCU an official transcript summary and evaluation of all college course work will be completed and transcript credit applied according to TCU admissions policies. This summary will be sent to you.
- Admission to TCU does not guarantee admission to nursing clinical

Items to be mailed to NursingCAS and submitted via NursingCAS	All official transcripts (even if you are currently enrolled at this institution) must be mailed from each issuing institution's registrar's office directly to NursingCAS. In order to expedite the processing be sure to include the Transcript Request Form. Nursing processes your transcripts on behalf of the university. Designations	Required. In this section you will select Texas Christian University's program(s), search or scroll to find our school listing and click on the box underneath apply next to the specialty track(s) you wish to apply to and hit "Submit". Note applicants applying to the Accelerated BSN should have a bachelor's degree in another discipline.
	If TCU is the only school you apply to through NursingCAS then you will be charged \$45. If it's the second school you apply to through NursingCAS then you be will charged \$30. Access <u>FAQs</u> on payment here.
Deadline	The application deadline is February 1, 2014 .
	ALL required admissions materials, including transcripts, must be submitted by the deadline.
	Do <u>not</u> wait until the last minute to submit your application. All official transcripts must be submitted to NursingCAS in order for your application to be processed and verified for TCU to review.

Use the "Quick Status Menu" options to check to see your Transcript(s), Reference(s), or Payment(s) have been received after you submit them. To check to see which Designations you have selected (in other words programs you have applied to) by clicking on the Designations option under the Quick Status menu. The GPA Calculations option under the Quick Status menu will display any GPA calculations NursingCAS has generated for you based on the coursework data you entered.
